**Summary:** Line(s) of strong to severe thunderstorms began impacting Virginia around 2 p.m. and are expected to continue on and off until around midnight. Tornado watch is in effect until 9 p.m. for all areas of Virginia except far Southwest Virginia. Severe thunderstorm warnings and flash flooding warnings are in effect for areas of Central, Eastern, and Northern Virginia that are set to expire at various times during early evening hours. Flash flood watch is in effect until midnight for localities across Northwest and Northern Virginia.

Loudoun County emergency management reports National Weather Service personnel are en-route to Aldie area to inspect damage from possible tornado.
