### SUMMARY

New items in bold

Severe thunderstorms with winds surpassing 80 mph impacted the Commonwealth on the evening of Friday, 29 June, and continued into the early morning hours of Saturday, 30 June. Severe thunderstorms again impacted the Commonwealth on the evening of Saturday, 30 June and afternoon of Sunday, 1 July.

### EXECUTIVE ACTION

Governor Bob McDonnell declared a State of Emergency at 1100 hours on 30 June due to severe weather that impacted the Commonwealth on 29 June.

**Governor Bob McDonnell submitted request for Major Disaster Declaration on Friday, July 20, 2012 to FEMA Region III for processing and forwarding to President Obama**

**Fatalities (15): Virginia Department of Health, Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, confirmed two additional storm related deaths**
